# Guideline for Abstract Submissions

1. Abstracts may have multiple authors; at least one author must register for and attend the conference.
2. The submitting author should input all author details and upload their abstract using the abstract template (consisted of purpose, method, results, conclusion, and keywords).
3. All submitted abstracts should use a word count of 250 words or less (excluding title and key words).
3. Participants can choose oral or poster presentation or both with a maximum of 2 abstracts (as first author/co-author).
5. All abstracts must be submitted in English.
6. All abstracts will be double-blind reviewed for the quality of content.
